

shall be extended to the succeeding year *unless such extension will cause more than three council members to be elected at any election, in which case the term of every such officer shall be shortened to the preceding year. Any village which has adopted a biennial election system under this act and which elects more than three council members at any such election shall by ordinance provide that one or more such officers be elected for a shorter term in order to comply with the requirement that no more than three council members be elected at each biennial election. No such ordinance need be submitted to the voters for approval.* At each biennial village election, successors to incumbents whose terms will expire in the following January shall be chosen for four-year terms, except in the case of constables and justices of the peace, if any, who shall serve for two-year terms.

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CHAPTER 239—H. F. No. 1850

*An act excluding storm sewer bonds issued by the city of Mankato from "net debt."*

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

**Section 1. Mankato, city of; storm sewer bonds.** General obligation bonds issued by the council of the city of Mankato to finance the acquisition and betterment of storm sewers shall not constitute "net debt" within the meaning of Minnesota Statutes, Section 475.51. Except as otherwise provided, bonds shall be authorized, issued, and sold in the manner provided by Minnesota Statutes, Chapters 429 and 475.

**Sec. 2.** This act takes effect when approved by the governing body of the city of Mankato, and upon compliance with Minnesota Statutes, Section 645.021.

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CHAPTER 240—H. F. No. 2483

*An act appropriating money for legislative and related expenses.*

**Changes or additions indicated by italics, deletions by ~~strikeout~~.**

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

**Section 1. Legislature; expense appropriation.** Subdivision 1. The sums of money hereinafter set forth, or so much thereof as may be necessary, are appropriated from the general revenue fund in the state treasury for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1969, for the purposes specified in this section.

Subd. 2. For the house of representatives, salaries, supplies, and expense \$425,000

Subd. 3. For the senate, salaries, supplies, and expense 250,000

Subdivisions 2 and 3 supplement the appropriations made by Extra Session Laws 1967, Chapter 48, Section 2, Subdivision 2, and are for the same purposes and subject to the same terms and conditions.

Subd. 4. For the revisor of statutes, bill drafting—salaries and expense for the 1969 legislature 6,000

This appropriation supplements previous appropriations for the same purposes.

Sec. 2. This act is in effect from and after its final enactment.

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#### CHAPTER 241—H. F. No. 230

*An act relating to the unauthorized use of a motor vehicle and the punishment therefor; amending Minnesota Statutes 1967, Section 609.55, Subdivision 2.*

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

**Section 1.** Minnesota Statutes 1967, Section 609.55, Subdivision 2, is amended to read:

Subd. 2. **Motor vehicles; unauthorized use; acts constituting.** Whoever intentionally takes ~~and~~ or drives a motor vehicle without the consent of the owner or his authorized agent may be sentenced to imprisonment for not more than three years or to payment of a fine of not more than \$3,000, or both.
