## CHAPTER 273-H. F. No. 165

An act relating to municipal housing and redevelopment authorities; amending Minnesota Statutes 1967, Section 462.425, Subdivision 5.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Section 1. Minnesota Statutes 1967, Section 462.425, Subdivision 5, is amended to read:

Subd. 5. Municipal housing and redevelopment: commissioners. An authority shall consist of five commissioners, who shall be residents of the area of operation of the authority, who shall be appointed after the resolution provided for in this section becomes finally effective. No public officer or employee of the municipality in which the authority is organized shall be eligible to serve as a commissioner, but a commissioner may be a notary public. In cities of the first class a public officer or employee other than a notary public is not eligible to serve as a commissioner, except where permitted by special law.

## CHAPTER 274—H. F. No. 202

An act relating to public employees retirement association; providing for the payment of survivorship benefits to the widows of former school district employees upon the prepayment of certain refunds.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Section 1. [353.84] P.E.R.A.; survivorship benefits to widows of certain employees. Notwithstanding any provisions of Minnesota Statutes 1967, Chapter 353, to the contrary, former employees of a school district who died on August 9, 1960, and who were school district employees between June 1, 1951, and September 30, 1958, shall be deemed members of the public employees retirement association on the date of their death, providing there is paid into the public employees retirement association fund the amount of contributions to such fund which such employees were required to make as salary deductions for the period between June 1, 1951 and
