suant to chapters 261, 262, and 263, the following amounts are excluded from a person's income or resources for the purposes of determining the person's need under any of the above mentioned programs:

(1) \$20 per week training incentive allowance under the manpower development and training act of 1962, as amended, and

(2) Such sums as are paid to defray training expenses under the same act.

Sec. 2. Minnesota Statutes 1967, Sections 245.071 and 256.735 are repealed.

Sec. 3. The effective date of this act shall be July 1, 1969. Approved May 9, 1969.

An act relating to wild animals; authorizing the commissioner to establish as game refuges not to exceed one third of the total area in a county acquired for public hunting grounds, game refuges, and other wildlife management areas; amending Minnesota Statutes 1967, Section 97.48, Subdivision 13.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Section 1. Minnesota Statutes 1967, Section 97.48, Subdivision 13, is amended to read:

Subd. 13. Game refuges; area. The commissioner shall acquire by gift, lease, easement, purchase, or condemnation in the manner prescribed under section 117.20, in the name of the state, lands or any interest in lands suitable and desirable for establishing and maintaining public hunting grounds, game refuges and food and cover planting areas, and to make all improvements thereon deemed by him advisable, provided that not more than one third of any the total area so acquired in any county for a public hunting grounds, or game refuge, food and cover planting area, or other wildlife management area shall be established as a refuge.
