and the craft is drifting, beached, moored, resting at anchor, or is being propelled by paddle, oars, or pole.

CHAPTER 780--H. F. No. 2036

An act relating to the powers and duties of the commissioner of administration; authorizing the rental of certain state owned property; amending Minnesota Statutes 1967, Section 16.02, Subdivision 14.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Section 1. Minnesota Statutes 1967, Section 16.02, Subdivision 14, is amended to read:

Subd. 14. State property; rental. To rent out, with the approval of the governor, any state property, real or personal, not needed for public use, the rental of which is not otherwise provided for or prohibited by law;. This shall not apply to state trust fund lands, or other state lands under the jurisdiction of the department of conservation, or to property under the jurisdiction of the conservator of rural credit, or to lands forfeited for delinquent taxes; or to lands acquired under Minnesota Statutes, Section 298.22. No such property shall be rented out for a term exceeding two years at a time excepting property nequired under Minnesota Statutes; Section 298.22. Any rentals of property heretefore made under Minnesota Statutes, Section 298.22 for more than two years are hereby validated without the approval of the state executive council; and no such property shall ever be rented out for more than 25 years.
