

CHAPTER 959—H. F. No. 2889

An act relating to counties; Itasca county welfare board membership; authorizing an election on question.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Section 1. **Itasca county; welfare board.** At the next general election to be held in Itasca county the following proposition shall be submitted to the voters for an advisory referendum:

“Shall the composition and selection of the Itasca county welfare and hospital boards be changed so that they be the county commissioners together with two other persons, one of whom shall be a woman, appointed by the commissioner of public welfare, as provided for in Minnesota Statutes 393.01 and 376.06?”

Sec. 2. This act is effective upon approval by the board of county commissioners of Itasca county and upon compliance with Minnesota Statutes, Section 645.021.

CHAPTER 960—H. F. No. 2898

An act authorizing the state to convey certain lands in Washington county to James R. McConnell and Carma J. McConnell.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Section 1. **Conveyance of state lands; McConnell.** Subdivision 1. The governor, upon behalf of the state of Minnesota and upon recommendation of the commissioners of administration and corrections, may grant and convey by quit claim deed, in a form approved by the attorney general, upon such consideration, terms and conditions as agreed upon, to James R. McConnell and Carma J. McConnell, husband and wife, the following described land in Washington county, to-wit:

All that part of the Southeast Quarter of the Southeast Quarter (SE 1/4 of SE 1/4) of Section Four (4), Township Twenty-nine (29) North, Range Twenty (20) West, described as fol-

lows: Beginning at a point on the South line of said Section Four (4), 666.3 feet East of the Southwest corner of the Southeast Quarter of the Southeast Quarter (SE 1/4 of SE 1/4) of said Section Four (4); thence North and parallel to the West line of the said Southeast Quarter of the Southeast Quarter (SE 1/4 of SE 1/4) of Section Four (4), a distance of 35.0 feet; thence in an Easterly direction to a point on the East line of the said Southeast Quarter of the Southeast Quarter (SE 1/4 of SE 1/4) of Section Four (4), 43.8 feet North of the Southeast corner of Section Four (4); thence South along the East line of the Southeast Quarter of the Southeast Quarter (SE 1/4 of SE 1/4) of Section Four (4), 43.8 feet more or less to the Southeast corner of said Section Four (4), thence West along the South line of said Section Four (4) to the point of beginning.

CHAPTER 961—H. F. No. 2926

An act authorizing Douglas and Kandiyohi counties to form districts for the construction of water or sewer facilities or both and to acquire land and easements, impose service charges, levy special assessments, and issue bonds for that purpose.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Section 1. Douglas and Kandiyohi counties; water and sewer facilities. The board of county commissioners of either or both of the counties of Douglas and Kandiyohi upon receipt of a petition for the formation of a water or sewer district or combined water and sewer district within any area of the county not organized into cities or villages, and after determining the sufficiency of the petition as provided in section 2 and making such investigations and surveys as it considers necessary to ascertain whether it should be granted, may by resolutions form such a district; cause plans and specifications to be prepared for facilities adequate to obtain, store, treat, and distribute water for domestic, commercial, and industrial use therein, or facilities adequate to collect, treat, and dispose of sewage and waste in a sanitary manner, or both such types of facilities; contract for the construction of such facilities; acquire land and easements for the purpose within or outside the district by purchase, gift, condemnation, or other lawful means; establish, collect, and revise charges for the use
