**PROCLAMATION OF ADOPTION OF
CONSTITUTIONAL AMENDMENTS
PROCLAMATION**

I, Harold LeVander, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim and certify that under and pursuant to the laws of the State of Minnesota providing therefor, the following amendments to the Minnesota Constitution were duly passed at the General Election held in the State of Minnesota on November 5, 1968, viz:

Article IV, Section 9 is amended to read:

"No senator or representative shall hold any other office under the authority of the United States or the State of Minnesota, except that of postmaster or notary public. If elected or appointed to another office, a legislator may resign from the legislature by tendering his resignation to the governor."

Article IV, Section 11 is amended in part to read:

". . . If any bill shall not be returned by the governor within three days (Sundays excepted) after it shall have been presented to him, the same shall be a law in like manner as if he had signed it, unless the legislature, by adjournment within that time, prevents its return. Bills may be presented to the governor during the three days following the day of final adjournment of the legislature and the legislature may prescribe the method of performing the acts necessary to present bills to the governor after adjournment. The governor may approve, sign and file in the office of the secretary of state within 14 days after the adjournment of the legislature, any act passed during the last three days of the session, and the same shall become a law. If any bill passed during the last three days of the session is not signed and filed within 14 days after the adjournment, it shall not become a law."

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, I have hereunto set my hand and caused the Great Seal of the State of Minnesota to be affixed this twenty-second day of November in the year of our Lord one thousand nine hundred and sixty-eight, and of the State, the one hundred eleventh.
