RESOLUTION 4—H. F. No. 689

*A resolution memorializing Congress and the President to enact a law comparable to the "Older Americans Act Amendments of 1968."*

WHEREAS, the Ninetieth Congress of the United States considered an act to be called the "Older Americans Act Amendments of 1968"; and

WHEREAS, that act would have provided much needed funds for senior citizen centers and other senior citizens programs; and

WHEREAS, the proposed centers and associated projects are highly desirable for the development of the proper programs of care for older Americans; now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota, that Congress and the President should speedily enact amendments to the Older Americans Act similar to the "Older Americans Act Amendments of 1968," H.R. 4261 of the Ninetieth Congress.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Secretary of State of the State of Minnesota transmit copies of this resolution to the President and Vice President of the United States, the Speaker of the United States House of Representatives, the Chairman of the Labor and Public Welfare Committee of the United States Senate, the Chairman of the Education and Labor Committee of the United States House of Representatives, and to the Minnesota Senators and Representatives in Congress.
