## CHAPTER 295—H.F.No.2303

An act relating to public employees retirement; merging hospital employees into the public employees coordinated law; amending Minnesota Statutes 1969, Sections 353.51 and 353.52, Subdivision 1; repealing Minnesota Statutes 1969, Sections 355.82 to 355.89.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Section 1. Minnesota Statutes 1969, Section 353.51, is amended to read:

353.51 P.E.R.A.; HOSPITAL EMPLOYEES; SCOPE AND AP-PLICATION. Sections 353.51 to 353.59 apply to any <u>hospital employee</u>, as defined by section 355.71 and any member of the public employees retirement association included in any agreement or modification made between the state and the secretary of health, education and welfare, making the provisions of the federal old age and survivors insurance act applicable to such member. Sections 353.51 to 353.59 also apply to any government subdivision employing such member. Except as otherwise specifically provided in sections 353.51 to 353.59, the provisions of Minnesota Statutes, Chapter 353, shall apply.

Sec. 2. Minnesota Statutes 1969, Section 353.52, Subdivision 1, is amended to read:

353.52 CONTRIBUTIONS BY EMPLOYEES AND EM-PLOYERS. Subdivision 1. EMPLOYEE CONTRIBUTION. The employee contribution to the public employees retirement fund shall be an amount equal to three percent of the salary of every member. This contribution shall be made by deduction from salary<u>in the manner provided in section 353.27, subdivision 4</u>. Where any portion of a member's salary is paid from other than public funds, employee and employer's contributions will be made only on that part of the salary paid from public funds such member's employee contribution shall be based on the total salary received from all sources.

Sec. 3. <u>Minnesota Statutes 1969</u>, <u>Sections 355.82</u>, <u>355.83</u>, <u>355.84</u>, <u>355.85</u>, <u>355.86</u>, <u>355.87</u>, <u>355.88</u> and <u>355.89</u> are repealed.
