CHAPTER 319—H.F.No.2407

An act relating to securities; providing for an exemption from registration for sales to investment companies; amending Minnesota Statutes 1969, Section 80.06, Subdivision 8.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Section 1. Minnesota Statutes 1969, Section 80.06, Subdivision 8, is amended to read:

Subd. 8. SECURITIES; SALES TO INVESTMENT COMPANIES. The offer or sale to any licensed broker-dealer, investment company registered under the Investment Company Act of 1940 or to any bank or financial institution under the supervision of an instrumentality or officer of the United States or of the commissioner of banks or of the commissioner of insurance of this state.

CHAPTER 320—H.F.No.2438

An act relating to highway traffic regulations; tail-gates, loading racks, or partitions on trucks; amending Minnesota Statutes 1969, Section 169.43.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Section 1. Minnesota Statutes 1969, Section 169.43, is amended to read:

169.43 HIGHWAY TRAFFIC REGULATIONS; TRUCKS; SWINGING GATES. No truck shall be operated on any highway with gate, loading rack, or partition carried in any manner on any part of the exterior of the truck, unless the top and bottom of such gate, loading rack or partition is securely attached to the truck, so as to prevent swinging or becoming loose—except that no such gate, loading rack or partition shall be carried on the left side of the truck.

No truck shall be driven or parked on any highway with tail-gate or tail-board hanging down or projecting from the vehicle except while such vehicle is being loaded or unloaded, and except when a load on the tail-board renders impossible the closing of the tail-board.
