<u>Subd. 3.</u> No person shall be eligible to apply for or to be issued a license, unless they are a resident of the state and at least 16 years of age prior to the opening of the moose season.

<u>Subd. 4.</u> No person may make more than one application in any given season. Upon a finding by the commissioner, without hearing, that a person has made more than one application, then such person shall become ineligible for a license that year. Any person who makes more than one application in any one year shall be guilty of a misdemeanor.

<u>Subd. 5.</u> No application or license shall be transferable at any time or for any reason.

Sec. 15. LIMITED SEASON. Notwithstanding any other provision of this act, only one moose season may be set between January 1, 1971 and December 31, 1972. For the purposes of this section a split season in any calendar year shall be considered as one season.

An act relating to Hennepin county; salary and employment of court reporters in the fourth judicial district; amending Laws 1969, Chapter 568, Section I.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Section 1. Laws 1969, Chapter 568, Section 1, is amended to read:

Section 1. HENNEPIN COUNTY; DISTRICT COURT RE-PORTERS; SALARY. <u>Subdivision 1.</u> Notwithstanding Minnesota Statutes, Section 486.05, or any other law to the contrary, the salary of district court reporters in the fourth judicial district is established at <u>\$12,500</u> <u>\$14,500</u> per year, as of the effective date of this act, <u>exclusive of insurance benefits. The salary shall be paid in biweekly</u> <u>installments in the same manner as Hennepin county employees are</u> <u>paid</u>. Such reporters shall not be under the jurisdiction of the Hennepin county personnel board.

<u>Subd. 2.</u> Insurance benefits shall be provided the district court reporters in the fourth judicial district at the expense of the county on the same basis as they are provided Hennepin county employees.

#### CHAPTER 609-H.F.No.1272

An act relating to the use of federal census information by the state auditor for the purpose of making certain tax apportionments.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Section 1. STATE AUDITOR; TAX APPORTIONMENTS; FEDERAL CENSUS. If the state auditor is required to use the 1960 federal decennial census or any more recent census authorized for the purpose of making apportionments of the proceeds of certain taxes as provided by law upon the basis of population of the various political subdivisions entitled thereto because the 1970 final federal census information is unavailable, he shall make an adjustment thereof in subsequent apportionments if there is a difference in the population figures between the 1960 federal decennial census or any more recent census authorized and the final 1970 census.

Sec. 2. The adjustment shall apply to distributions in the year 1971 only. Thereafter distributions shall be made based on the 1970 census as certified to the state auditor or on a subsequent mid-decennial census as authorized by law.
