# CHAPTER 9-H.F.No.335

An act relating to banking and certain records kept by the commissioner of banks; amending Minnesota Statutes 1969, Section 46.07, Subdivision 2.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Section 1. Minnesota Statutes 1969, Section 46.07, Subdivision 2, is amended to read:

Subd. 2. BANKS AND BANKING; RECORDS. The commissioner shall divulge facts and information obtained in the course of examining financial institutions under his supervision only when and to the extent that he is required or permitted by law to report upon or take special action regarding the affairs of any such institution, or to testify in any criminal proceeding or in a court of justice, except that he may, in his discretion, furnish information as to matters of mutual interest to an official or examiner of the Federal Reserve System, or of the Federal Deposit Insurance Corporation, or of the National <u>Credit Union Administration</u>. The commissioner shall not be required to disclose the name of any debtor of any financial institution under his supervision, or anything relative to the private accounts, ownership, or transactions of any such institution, or any fact obtained in the course of any examination thereof, except as herein provided.

#### CHAPTER 10-S.F.No.279

An act relating to institutions under the control of the commissioner of corrections; prohibiting trespass upon the grounds thereof; amending Minnesota Statutes 1969, Section 243.21.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Section 1. Minnesota Statutes 1969, Section 243.21, is amended to read:

243.21 CORRECTIONAL INSTITUTIONS; TRESPASS ON GROUNDS. No person shall trespass or loiter upon the grounds of the

state prison, the state reformatory for men, the Minnesota correctional institution for women,—or upon any farm or camp or other establishments belonging to the prison or reformatory, <u>or upon the</u> <u>grounds of any other institution or facility under the control of the</u> <u>commissioner of corrections</u> without the consent of the warden or superintendent thereof; nor shall any person communicate or in any way assist in establishing communication with any inmate of the state prison or reformatory <u>or other institution or facility</u> except as permitted by law or authorized by the warden or superintendent thereof. Whoever violates any of the provisions hereof shall be guilty of a misdemeanor.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Section 1. Minnesota Statutes 1969, Section 69.77, is amended by adding a subdivision to read:

<u>Subd.</u> 2a. POLICE AND FIREMEN'S RELIEF ASSOCIA-TIONS; RATIFICATION OF BYLAWS AND ARTICLES. <u>After</u> January 1, 1971, all bylaws or articles of incorporation amendments affecting benefits paid for any police or fire association governed by this section, shall not be effective until ratified by the local governmental subdivision.
