**CHAPTER 166—H.F.No.471**

*An act expanding the jurisdiction of the probate court in certain counties; amending Minnesota Statutes 1969, Section 525.011, Subdivision 1.*

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Section 1. Minnesota Statutes 1969, Section 525.011, Subdivision 1, is amended to read:

**525.011 PROBATE COURT; CIVIL AND CRIMINAL JURISDICTION.** Subdivision 1. Except in counties having a city of the first class or in counties having a population of more than 30,000 according to the 1950 federal census, the probate court shall also exercise the powers, duties and jurisdiction conferred upon municipal courts by Minnesota Statutes, ~~Chapter~~ Chapters 488, 491, 492, and 493, or under any other law enacted in lieu thereof which provides for uniform powers, duties and jurisdiction of municipal courts.
