CHAPTER 179-H.F.No.1083

An act relating to interstate compact for education; responsibilities and membership of the Minnesota education council; amending Minnesota Statutes 1969, Section 121.83.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Section 1. Minnesota Statutes 1969, Section 121.83, is amended to read:

121.83 EDUCATION: INTERSTATE COMPACT: MINNESO-TA EDUCATION COUNCIL. There is hereby established the Minnesota education council composed of the members of the education commission of the states representing this state, and 64 32 other persons, eight four from each congressional district of which two shall be legislators, appointed by the governor for terms coinciding with the term of the appointing governor. Such other Persons other than legislators shall be selected so as to be broadly representative of professional and lay-interest interests within this state having the responsibilities for, knowledge with respect to, and interest in educational matters. The chairman shall be designated by the governor from among its members. The council shall meet on the call of the governor, but in any event the council shall meet not less than-once twice in each year. The council may consider any and all matters relating to recommendations of the education commission of the states and the activities of the members in representing this state thereon, shall serve as a forum for major education policies, and shall serve to exchange information about important education activities of interest to all parties. Members of the council shall serve without pay salary, and without reimbursement but may be reimbursed for actual and necessary expenses incurred in attendance at meetings of the council at rates provided by law for state employees and officials.

CHAPTER 180—H.F.No.1379

An act relating to Chisago county and the issuance of revenue bonds and the acquisition of property by said county for nursing home facilities.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Section 1. CHISAGO COUNTY; NURSING HOME; REVE-NUE BONDS. The county board of Chisago county, is authorized to issue revenue bonds for the acquisition and betterment of an addition to the Chisago county nursing home facilities, and to pledge and appropriate the revenues to be derived from its operation of the nursing home facilities to pay the principal and interest on the bonds when due and to create and maintain reserves for that purpose, as a first and prior lien on all such revenues or, if so provided in the bond resolution, as a lien thereon subordinate to the current payment of a fixed amount or percentage or all of the annual costs of the operation, administration, and maintenance of the facilities. Revenue bonds shall not be included in the district's net debt for the purpose of any limitation. In the issuance of such bonds the revenues or lease rentals from any or all facilities may be pledged and appropriated by resolution for the use and benefit of the bondholders, or may be pledged by the execution of an indenture or other appropriate instrument to a trustee for the bondholders. The county board shall have power to make and enter into any and all covenants with the bondholders or trustee which are determined by it to be necessary or proper to assure the marketability of the bonds, the completion of the facilities, the segregation of the revenues or rentals and any other funds pledged, and the sufficiency thereof for the prompt and full payment of all bonds and interest. Such bonds shall be authorized, issued, and sold in accordance with the provisions of Minnesota Statutes, Chapter 475, relating to obligations payable wholly from the income of revenue producing public conveniences.

Sec. 2. This act shall become effective upon approval by resolution adopted by a majority vote of all members of the Chisago county board, and upon compliance with Minnesota Statutes, Section 645.021.
