Section 1. NEW HOPE, VILLAGE OF: REFUNDING TEM-PORARY IMPROVEMENT BONDS. The village of New Hope is hereby authorized to issue refunding temporary improvement bonds for the purpose of paying and refunding at maturity, the principal amount of any of its temporary improvement bonds issued during the years 1970 and 1971 in accordance with Minnesota Statutes, Section 429.091, Subdivision 3, to the extent that such principal amount cannot be paid out of the assessments and taxes, if any, levied for its payment and theretofore collected, or out of other funds determined by the village council to be available. Such refunding temporary improvement bonds may be authorized to be issued by resolution of the council whenever it is deemed necessary and expedient to do so. The terms of their sale and issuance and the rights of the holders thereof shall be the same as is provided by said section 429.091, subdivision 3, with respect to the temporary improvement bonds. No holder of any temporary improvement bond of such village, outstanding the date this act becomes effective, shall be required to accept in payment or in exchange therefore any refunding temporary improvement bond issued hereinunder.

Sec. 2. This act shall be effective only after its approval by a resolution adopted by a favorable vote of a majority of the members of the council of said village, and upon compliance with Minnesota Statutes, Section 645.021.
