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### CHAPTER 290—H.F.No.1789

*An act relating to highways; acquisition of road or street building materials for road or street purposes; amending Minnesota Statutes 1969, Section 160.11, Subdivisions 1 and 2; repealing Minnesota Statutes 1969, Section 160.11, Subdivision 3.*

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Section 1. Minnesota Statutes 1969, Section 160.11, Subdivision 1, is amended to read:

**160.11 HIGHWAYS; BUILDING MATERIALS; ACQUISITION.** Subdivision 1. **ACQUISITION OF LANDS.** When the commissioner of highways, any county board, town board, or ~~council governing body of any village, or city or borough,~~ each hereinafter referred to as road authority, shall deem it necessary for the purpose of building or repairing public roads or streets within its jurisdiction, it may procure by lease, purchase, gift, or condemnation in the manner provided by law any lands within the state containing any materials suitable for road or street purposes, together with the right of way to the same of sufficient width to allow ~~teams, trucks,~~ or other vehicles to pass, and on the most practicable route to the nearest public road or street.

Sec. 2. Minnesota Statutes 1969, Section 160.11, Subdivision 2, is amended to read:

Subd. 2. **SALE OF ROAD OR STREET BUILDING MATERIALS BY ROAD AUTHORITIES.** ~~The county board, town board, or council of any city or village~~ Any such road authority may engage in the processing of crushed rock or other road or street building material for use on public roads or streets within ~~their respective jurisdictions~~ its jurisdiction; and any such road authorities authority, including the commissioner of highways, may by agreement sell to any other road authority any ~~unprocessed or pit-run sand,~~

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rock, crushed rock, processed sand or gravel, unprocessed or pit-run sand or gravel, or other earth material suitable for road or street purposes, upon terms and conditions as may be mutually agreed upon by the parties, except that the commissioner of highways shall not sell processed gravel, processed sand, or crushed rock.

Sec. 3. Minnesota Statutes 1969, Section 160.11, Subdivision 3, is repealed.

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### CHAPTER 291—H.F.No.1833

*An act relating to the compensation of the court commissioner in Ramsey county; amending Laws 1957, Chapter 448, Section 3; repealing Laws 1955, Chapter 703, Section 4.*

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Section 1. Laws 1957, Chapter 448, Section 3, is amended to read:

**Sec. 3. RAMSEY COUNTY; COURT COMMISSIONER; COMPENSATION; APPLICATION.** This act shall not apply to any elective officer except court commissioner nor to any officer whose appointment or compensation is pursuant to Laws 1923, Chapter 77, as amended, Minnesota Statutes 1953, Sections 260.14, 508.12, 611.13, 636.09 and 636.10, nor by Laws 1929, Chapter 371, nor shall it apply to the officers or employees of any agency supported by moneys provided by said county and by a city of the first class situated therein.

Sec. 2. Laws 1955, Chapter 703, Section 4, is repealed.

Sec. 3. This act shall take effect upon its approval by the board of county commissioners of Ramsey county, and upon compliance with Minnesota Statutes, Section 645.021.
