

**574.32 BONDS; FILING OF NOTICE; FEE.** The commissioner of insurance or the county auditor in whose office the written notice is filed shall, upon receipt of such written notice, mail one copy of the same, by registered mail, to the principal contractor, at his last known address, and to each of the sureties on his bond, at their last known addresses, and the claimant shall, at the time he files the written notice, furnish the commissioner of insurance or the county auditor in whose office the notice is filed, at least two copies of the notice. The commissioner of insurance or county auditor with whom the notice is filed shall be entitled to charge a fee of ~~\$1~~ \$3 for filing the notice and mailing the copies as herein provided. The failure of the commissioner of insurance or the county auditor with whom the notice is filed to mail these copies as herein provided, shall in no way affect the validity of the claim or the right of the claimant to maintain an action thereon.

**CHAPTER 294—H.F.No.2099**

*An act relating to Scott county; per diem allowance to the chairman of the county welfare board.*

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

**Section 1. SCOTT COUNTY; WELFARE BOARD; CHAIRMAN'S PER DIEM.** Notwithstanding the provisions of Minnesota Statutes, Section 393.03, in the county of Scott a county commissioner, other than the chairman of the county board, who also serves as chairman of the county welfare board of the county may receive the same maximum per diem for services on the welfare board as the chairman of the county board of the county receives as a per diem under the provisions of Minnesota Statutes, Section 375.055, Subdivision 5.

**Sec. 2.** This act takes effect when approved by the county board of Scott county and upon compliance with Minnesota Statutes, Section 645.021.
