

CHAPTER 309—H.F.No.1490

An act relating to highway traffic regulations; transferring certain powers from the department of highways to the department of public safety; amending Minnesota Statutes 1969, Section 169.221, Subdivision 6.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Section 1. Minnesota Statutes 1969, Section 169.221, Subdivision 6, is amended to read:

Subd. 6. **HIGHWAY TRAFFIC REGULATIONS; BICYCLES; APPROVAL OF REFLECTOR TYPE.** (a) Every bicycle when in use at nighttime shall be equipped with a lamp on the front which shall emit a white light visible from a distance of at least 500 feet to the front and with a red reflector on the rear of a type approved by the department of public safety which is visible from all distances from 50 feet to 300 feet to the rear when directly in front of lawful upper beams of head lamps on a motor vehicle. A lamp emitting a red light visible from a distance of 500 feet to the rear may be used in addition to the red reflector.

(b) Every bicycle shall be equipped with a brake which will enable the operator to make the braked wheels skid on dry, level, clean pavement.

CHAPTER 310—H.F.No.1520

An act relating to Ramsey county; transferring the functions of the auditor, treasurer, court commissioner and register of deeds to the county board of commissioners; and authorizing the reorganization, reallocation, consolidation, or delegation of such functions.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Section 1. **RAMSEY COUNTY; REORGANIZATION OF COUNTY OFFICES.** In the county of Ramsey the offices of county auditor, county treasurer, court commissioner, and register of deeds shall not be elective but shall be filled by appointment by the Ramsey
