CHAPTER 632—S.F.No.2702

*An act relating to county agricultural societies; providing funds for the maintenance and support of county extension work in certain counties; and amending Laws 1969, Chapter 589, Section 1.*

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Section 1. Laws 1969, Chapter 589, Section 1, is amended to read:

Section 1. **COUNTY AGRICULTURAL SOCIETIES; MAINTENANCE OF COUNTY EXTENSION WORK.** Notwithstanding the limitation contained in Minnesota Statutes, Section 38.36, the county boards of Hennepin, Ottertail, and Ramsey may each annually levy an amount of not to exceed \$40,000 over and above any existing tax limitation for maintenance and support of county extension work, and the county boards of Anoka and Olmsted may each annually levy an amount of not to exceed \$45,000 over and above any existing tax limitation for the maintenance and support of county extension work, and the county boards of Hennepin and Ramsey counties may each annually appropriate an amount of not to exceed \$20,000 from their respective general revenue funds for the maintenance and support of county extension work in addition to existing levy limits.

Sec. 2. This act shall take effect as to each of the counties of Hennepin and Ramsey upon its approval by the board of county commissioners of each county, and upon compliance with Minnesota Statutes, Section 645.021.
