- (13) To exercise and perform such further powers and duties as may be required or imposed upon the commissioner of taxation by law-:
- (14) The commissioner of taxation may promulgate rules and regulations for the administration and enforcement of the property tax. Such rules and regulations shall have the force and effect of law.

CHAPTER 671—S.F.No.1884

An act relating to the powers of the commissioner of highways; the employment of consultants; amending Minnesota Statutes 1969, Section 161.35.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Section 1. Minnesota Statutes 1969, Section 161.35, is amended to read:

161.35 HIGHWAYS; EMPLOYMENT OF CONSULTANTS. Until July 1, 1971, Until July 1, 1975. The commissioner is authorized to employ and engage the services of registered professional engineers, engineering firms, and registered land surveyors, to act as consultants in connection with and to prepare plans and specifications or to perform aerial photography and survey work preliminary to the preparation of plans and specifications themselves or by their organizations and employees for the construction of trunk highways, and the commissioner is authorized to negotiate for and agree upon the terms and compensation for such employment and services. If the commissioner employs and engages an engineering firm, the person or persons in responsible charge of the work or service to be performed shall be registered professional engineers or land surveyors.

Provided, however, that the commissioner shall make available to the legislature a list of such consultants, the tasks for which they were hired, and the amount of compensation which they received.
