state historical society shall approve the design, structural composition, location, repair or removal of all public monuments, memorials or works of art presently located in the public areas of the state capitol or which shall be placed in such public areas after the effective date of this act. No public monument, memorial or work of art shall be relocated or removed from, or placed in such areas or altered or repaired in any way without the approval of the Minnesota state historical society.

CHAPTER 692—H.F.No.750

An act relating to education; the acceptance of federal assistance designed to meet the critical shortage of adequately trained education personnel in public schools with a concentration of disadvantaged pupils.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

- Section 1. [124.615] EDUCATION; EDUCATIONAL PERSONNEL; FEDERAL AID. Subdivision 1. ACCEPTANCE. The Minnesota state board of education is herewith authorized to accept and administer federal funds available under Public Law 90 35, the Higher Education Act, Title V, Part B, Subpart 2, which are provided to meet the critical shortage of adequately trained education personnel in public schools with a concentration of disadvantaged pupils.
- Sec. 2. [124.615] Subd. 2. STATE PLAN. The Minnesota state board of education shall adopt a state plan in conformity with the federal regulations and guidelines so that the funds may be utilized to the fullest extent.
- Sec. 3. [124.615] Subd. 3. STAFF. Available federal funds for the state administration of this act may be used for employment of necessary personnel in the department of education through classified or unclassified state service by contract for the period of time that the federal funds continue to be available therefor.
