

CHAPTER 912—H.F.No.1736

An act appropriating money from the general fund as a contingent appropriation for the game and fish fund.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Section 1. **GAME AND FISH; APPROPRIATION.** There is appropriated the sum of \$500,000 from the general fund in the state treasury as a contingent appropriation for the use and benefit of the game and fish fund in the state treasury. Transfers from the general fund to the game and fish fund under the terms of this appropriation may be made when authorized by the governor, but no such transfer shall be made until the governor has consulted with the legislative advisory committee and such committee has made their recommendation thereon. Such recommendation shall be advisory only. Failure or refusal on the part of the committee to make its recommendation promptly shall be considered a negative recommendation.

Sec. 2. The appropriation made by section 1 shall be available for the purposes therein stated for the biennium beginning July 1, 1971.

CHAPTER 913—H.F.No.1813

An act relating to distribution of gross earnings taxes; appropriating money to the city of Staples to correct for changes in the valuation of certain property.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Section 1. **STAPLES, CITY OF; GROSS EARNINGS AID; APPROPRIATION.** There is appropriated to the city of Staples from the general fund in the state treasury \$20,000 to compensate such city for the loss of gross earnings aid due to the decrease in valuation of certain railroad property located in the city.
