The bonds shall be sold, issued, and secured as provided in subdivisions 1 to 6 and in Article IX, Section 6, Subdivision 4, of the Constitution.

Sec. 7. This act is effective on July 1, 1971.

**EXTRA SESSION
CHAPTER 47—H.F.No.217**

An act relating to elections; setting the form of the oath administered to challenged voters; amending Minnesota Statutes 1969, Section 204.17, Subdivision 3.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Section 1. Minnesota Statutes 1969, Section 204.17, Subdivision 3, is amended to read:

Subd. 3. **ELECTIONS; CHALLENGED VOTERS; OATH; DETERMINATION OF RESIDENCE.** The judges, in determining the legal residence of any challenged person, shall be governed by the rules provided for the commissioner of registration in the Minnesota election law; and if the challenged person by his answers to the questions put to him reveals that he is not a qualified voter, he may not be allowed to vote. If, after all questions have been answered, the challenge is not withdrawn, the judge shall administer the following oath:

“Do you swear that you are a citizen of the United States; that you are 21 18 years of age; that you have been ~~a resident of this state for six months immediately preceding this election, and~~ an actual resident of this precinct for 30 days immediately preceding this election; that you are a qualified voter in this precinct and that you have not voted at this election?” When this oath is administered to a person who qualifies to vote under section 204.075, the judge shall strike the words “and an actual resident of this precinct for 30 days immediately preceding this election”. After taking this oath, the challenged person is entitled to vote.
