

## CHAPTER 136—S.F.No.908

*An act authorizing the commissioner of natural resources to convey the interests of the state in certain lands in Cass and Carlton counties.*

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

**Section 1. CONVEYANCE OF STATE LANDS; CASS AND CARLTON COUNTIES.** In the process of acquiring real property for public access sites, certain errors were made by the state of Minnesota which affect the ownership interests of adjacent private landowners. In order to correct these errors, the commissioner of natural resources in the name of the state may convey without consideration by quitclaim deed in such form as the attorney general approves all right, title, and interest of the state in the following described lands to the persons named below:

(a) To Irene Adams, the east 200 feet of Government Lot 3, Section 25, Township 140 North, Range 29 West, all in Cass County;

(b) To Charles E. Olson, all that part of Government Lot One (1), Section Nine (9), Township Forty-eight (48) North, Range Twenty-one (21) West, Carlton County, bounded by the water's edge of Tamarack Lake and the following described lines:

Commencing at a point on the north line of said Section 9 and the center line of Carlton County Aid Road No. 8; thence South 00 degrees 00 minutes, 356.55 feet; thence South 41 degrees 54 minutes West, 459.85 feet to the point of beginning; thence South 48 degrees 06 minutes East, 73.0 feet, more or less, to the water's edge of said lake and there terminating; and from the point of beginning, South 41 degrees 54 minutes West, 96.95 feet along the center line of County Aid Road No. 8, to a point of curve; thence continuing southerly on the center line of County Aid Road No. 8 on a tangential curve to the left with a radius of 161.7 feet a distance of 103.05 feet; thence South 84 degrees 46 minutes East, 117.0 feet, more or less, to the water's edge of said lake and there terminating.

Including all riparian rights to the contained 0.34 acre, more or less, and subject to existing road easements.

Sec. 2. This act is effective upon final enactment.
