

## CHAPTER 195—S.F.No.778

*An act relating to public welfare; extending the duration of foster care and day care licenses; amending Minnesota Statutes 1971, Section 257.101, Subdivision 2.*

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Section 1. Minnesota Statutes 1971, Section 257.101, Subdivision 2, is amended to read:

Subd. 2. **PUBLIC WELFARE; FOSTER CARE AND DAY CARE; LICENSING OF FACILITIES.** The commissioner of public welfare shall, subject to the provisions of Minnesota Statutes 1969, Chapter 15, establish by rule and regulation procedures and standards for the issuance and renewal of licenses and for the operation of foster care and day care facilities. Facilities which in the judgment of the commissioner of education operate for the primary purpose of educating children shall be exempt from these regulations ~~except insofar as the regulations affect the health and safety of the children therein. Licenses shall remain in force for one year and shall prescribe the number and age groupings of children who may receive care at any one time. Where an initial license is being issued to any facility it shall remain in force for one year. Where a license is being renewed it may be issued for a period of up to two years, in the discretion of the commissioner of public welfare. Every license shall prescribe the number and age groupings of children who may receive care at any one time.~~ A reasonable licensing fee may be charged to defray the expense of issuing such licenses.
