

CHAPTER 200—S.F.No.1327

An act relating to natural resources; directing the release of certain easements and conveyance of certain land in Kandiyohi county.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Section 1. CONVEYANCE OF STATE LANDS; KANDIYOHICOUNTY. The commissioner of natural resources on behalf of the state of Minnesota shall release by appropriate instrument of conveyance the following described dike easements, which are no longer required by the department, to the parties named:

(1) To George W. Welsh and Alfred D. Peterson, of the county of Hennepin, that dike easement dated April 2, 1956 and recorded in the office of the Kandiyohi county register of deeds as document #173368 in Book 29 of Miscellaneous Records at page 153.

(2) To Warren E. Johnson and Bruce C. Johnson, of Route 3, Willmar, Minnesota, that dike easement dated April 12, 1956 and recorded in the office of the Kandiyohi county register of deeds as document #173371 in Book 29 of Miscellaneous Records at page 156.

Sec. 2. The commissioner of natural resources on behalf of the state of Minnesota shall convey by appropriate instrument of conveyance the following described property situated in the county of Kandiyohi.

Beginning at a point on the south line of section twenty-two (22), township one hundred eighteen (118) north, range thirty-four (34) west, three hundred forty-three (343) feet east of the southeast corner of government lot six (6) of said section twenty-two (22), running thence east along said section line one hundred forty-one and four tenths (141.4) feet, thence north forty-five (45) degrees west two hundred (200) feet, thence west on a line parallel to said south line of said section one hundred forty-one and four tenths (141.4) feet, thence south forty-five (45) degrees east two hundred (200) feet to the place of beginning; containing forty-six one hundredths (.46) of an acre, more or less to Warren E. Johnson and Bruce C. Johnson of Route 3, Willmar, Minnesota, said property being no longer required as right of way for a water channel and ditch.
