Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Section 1. Minnesota Statutes 1971, Section 183.465, is amended to read:

183.465 SAFETY; BOILERS; INSPECTION STANDARDS. The engineering standards of boilers and unfired pressure vessels for use in this state shall be that established by the current edition of the construction code of the American Society of Mechanical Engineers and amendments thereto and the regulations of the division of boiler inspection adopted by the department of labor and industry. Notwithstanding this section or any other provision of law or code or rule to the contrary, the engineering standard for boilers on antique steam equipment used for educational and entertainment purposes only shall be a hydrostatic test of two times the operating pressure.

CHAPTER 239—S.F.No.1593

An act relating to game and fish; seasons for taking game birds; amending Minnesota Statutes 1971, Section 100.27, Subdivision 5.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Section 1. Minnesota Statutes 1971, Section 100.27, Subdivision 5, is amended to read:

Subd. 5. GAME AND FISH; GAME BIRDS; SEASON. Except as otherwise expressly provided, quail, partridges or ruffed grouse, Canada spruce grouse, pheasants, prairie chicken or pinnated grouse, white breasted or sharp tailed grouse, Hungarian partridge or chukar partridge, may be taken and possessed, subject to all other provisions of chapters 97 to 102, only in such areas of the state and during such times between September 16 and November 30 December 31, as the commissioner shall prescribe.
