

CHAPTER 297—H.F.No.190

An act relating to the village of Hugo; authorizing issuance of one additional on-sale license for the sale of intoxicating liquor.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Section 1. **HUGO, VILLAGE OF; ON-SALE LIQUOR LICENSE.** Notwithstanding the limitations contained in Minnesota Statutes, Section 340.11, Subdivision 7, or any other law, the village of Hugo, in Washington county, may issue one on-sale license for the sale of intoxicating liquor in addition to the number of licenses authorized therein.

Sec. 2. This act is effective February 1, 1974, and upon approval by the governing body of the village of Hugo and upon compliance with the provisions of Minnesota Statutes, Section 645.021.

CHAPTER 298—H.F.No.225

An act relating to municipalities; powers; providing for severance pay to employees; amending Minnesota Statutes 1971, Chapter 465, by adding a section; repealing Laws 1965, Chapters 621 and 690.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Section 1. Minnesota Statutes 1971, Chapter 465, is amended by adding a section to read:

[465.72] **MUNICIPALITIES; SEVERANCE PAY.** Except as may otherwise be provided in Laws 1959, Chapter 690, as amended, all counties, cities, villages, boroughs, townships and school districts are hereby authorized and empowered to pay severance pay to all of its employees and to establish, prescribe and promulgate provisions, rules and regulations for the payment of such severance pay upon leaving employment prior to the normal retirement date. Such severance pay shall be excluded from retirement deductions and from any calculations in retirement benefits, and shall be paid
