CHAPTER 301—H.F.No.400

An act relating to corrections; regulating the use of the revolving fund at the state prison; amending Minnesota Statutes 1971, Section 243.43.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Section 1. Minnesota Statutes 1971, Section 243.43 is amended to read:

- 243.43 CORRECTIONS; STATE PRISON REVOLVING FUND; USE OF FUND. Subdivision 1. The fund shall be used for the purchase of raw materials, payment of salaries and wages, and other expenses necessary and proper in the conduct of such industrial enterprises, authorized by law, and for such other purposes, or be devoted to such other uses, as may hereafter be by law duly authorized.
- Subd. 2. In addition to the authority contained in subdivision 1, the expenses of inmate vocational training and recreational programs may be financed from the fund in an amount not to exceed two thirds of the net profits from the industrial enterprises for the year immediately preceding the year the expenses are incurred.
- Subd. 3. The proceeds from the investment of money in the fund not currently needed shall be accounted for separately and credited to the fund.
