judgment against either or both the representative and his surety which may be filed and docketed like any other judgment in the district court and enforced in the same manner. This remedy shall be in addition to the action on the bond provided for in section 525.322.

Subd. 2. DIVORCE; RECIPROCAL ENFORCEMENT OF SUPPORT; STATE, DEFINITION. "State" includes a state, territory, or possession of the United States, and the District of Columbia and any foreign jurisdiction in which this or a substantially similar reciprocal law has been enacted.
