An act relating to wild animals; taking of small game by an owner or lessee of the land; amending Minnesota Statutes 1971, Section 98.47. Subdivision 10.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Section 1. Minnesota Statutes 1971, Section 98.47, Subdivision 10, is amended to read:

Subd. 10. GAME AND FISH; WILD ANIMALS; SMALL GAME; TAKING BY LANDOWNER OR LESSEE. The resident owner or lessee of any lands occupied by himself as a permanent abode, and any member of such person's immediate family residing with him, may take small game by hunting with legal firearms or bow and arrow and may trap protected fur bearing animals upon such lands without procuring a small game license, in any manner and at any time not otherwise prohibited by law.

An act relating to intoxicating liquor; issuance of on-sale licenses in certain municipalities.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Section 1. [340.353] Subd. 6. INTOXICATING LIQUORS; MUNICIPALITIES; LICENSES. Notwithstanding the provisions of Minnesota Statutes, Section 340.353, Subdivision 5, or any other law to the contrary, a city, village, or borough which did not permit any sale of intoxicating liquor within its boundaries as of June 30, 1969, or was incorporated after that date, may issue on-sale licenses for the sale of intoxicating liquor in accordance with the provisions of Minnesota Statutes, Section 340.353, Subdivision 5.
