Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Section 1. LEGISLATURE; PRE-SESSION ORIENTATION; EXPENSES. A representative-elect of the 68th legislature who attended pre-session orientation courses relating to the responsibilities and duties of legislators and the operation of the legislature shall be reimbursed for his expenses in attending such courses in the same manner and in the same amount as reimbursement is made to legislators who attend interim meetings of legislative committees.

Sec. 2. For the expenses of representatives-elect, as described in section 1, such sums of money as may be necessary are appropriated from the general fund to the legislative expense fund of the house of representatives.

Sec. 3. This act is in effect from and after its final passage. Approved February 20, 1973.

CHAPTER 5-S.F.No.159

[Coded in Part]

An act relating to the lieutenant governor; setting the salary thereof; appropriating moneys.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Section 1. [15A.081] LIEUTENANT GOVERNOR; SALARY. Subd. 1a. The salary of the lieutenant governor shall be \$30,000 annually.

Sec. 2. There is appropriated from the general fund in the state treasury the sum of \$11,850 to the lieutenant governor for the period ending June 30, 1973. This sum is in addition to moneys previously appropriated for this purpose.

Sec. 3. This act is effective as of January 2, 1973.
