authority and, in such an event, the Dakota county, housing and redevelopment authority shall act and have exclusive jurisdiction for housing in the municipality pursuant to the provisions of the municipal housing and redevelopment act, Minnesota Statutes, Sections 462.411 to 462.711, and acts amendatory thereof. A transfer of duties relating to housing shall not transfer any duties relating to redevelopment.

Sec. 2. This act takes effect when approved by a majority of the board of county commissioners of Dakota county, and upon compliance with Minnesota Statutes, Section 645.021.

An act relating to the city of Winona; authorizing the issuance of two additional on-sale liquor licenses.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

- Section 1. WINONA, CITY OF; ADDITIONAL LIQUOR LICENSES. Notwithstanding the limitations contained in Minnesota Statutes, Section 340.11, the city council of the city of Winona may, by unanimous action and after public hearing, issue not to exceed two licenses for the on-sale of intoxicating liquor in addition to the number authorized by section 340.11.
- Sec. 2. This act is effective upon approval by the city council of the city of Winona, and upon compliance with Minnesota Statutes, Section 645.021.
