An act relating to the cities of Mankato and North Mankato; authorizing tax levy for musical entertainment.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Section 1. MANKATO AND NORTH MANKATO, CITIES OF; MUSICAL ENTERTAINMENT. The cities of Mankato and North Mankato may, in 1973 and each year thereafter, levy a tax not to exceed one tenth of a mill on each dollar of assessed valuation of the taxable property of the cities in order to provide funds for musical entertainment.

Sec. 2. This act takes effect when approved by a majority of the governing body of the cities of Mankato and North Mankato and upon compliance with Minnesota Statutes, Section 645.021. Approved April 11, 1973.

An act relating to corrections; authorizing social service, educational and rehabilitative agencies, public or private, to utilize the facilities of state correctional institutions; amending Minnesota Statutes 1971, Section 241.01, by adding a subdivision.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Section 1. Minnesota Statutes 1971, Section 241.01, is amended by adding a subdivision to read:

Subd. 7. CORRECTIONAL INSTITUTIONS; USE OF FACILITIES OF INSTITUTION BY OUTSIDE AGENCIES. The commissioner of corrections may authorize and permit public or private social service, educational or rehabilitation agencies or organizations and their clients to enter upon and utilize the facilities, staff and other resources of institutions under his control and may require the participating agencies or organizations to pay all or part of the costs thereof. All sums of money received pursuant to the agreements herein authorized are hereby appropriated annually to the commissioner of corrections for the purposes of this act.
