An act relating to workmen's compensation; authorizing coverage for owners of businesses; amending Minnesota Statutes 1971, Chapter 176, by adding a section.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:

Section 1. Minnesota Statutes 1971, Chapter 176, is amended by adding a section to read:

[176.012] WORKMEN'S COMPENSATION; COVERAGE FOR OWNERS. For the purposes of chapter 176, an owner or owners of a business, including partners of a partnership owning a business, whether or not employing any other person to perform a service for hire, shall be included within the meaning of the term employee if such owner, owners, or partners elect to come under the provisions of chapter 176, and provide the insurance required thereunder. Nothing in this section shall be construed to limit the responsibilities of such owners or partners to provide coverage for their employees, if any, required under chapter 176.
