

after, respectively, required for different classes of vehicles, subject to exceptions with respect to parked vehicles, as hereinafter stated. In addition to the other requirements of this paragraph, every school bus transporting children upon a highway within this state, at any time from a half hour before sunrise to a half hour after sunset, shall display lighted lamps and illuminating devices as required by this paragraph, except that the operator shall use the lower most distribution of light specified in section 169.60 unless conditions warrant otherwise.

When requirement is hereinafter declared as to the distance from which certain lamps and devices shall render objects visible or within which such lamps or devices shall be visible, these provisions shall apply during the time stated in this section upon a straight level unlighted highway under normal atmospheric conditions unless a different time or condition is expressly stated and unless otherwise specified the location of lamps and devices shall refer to the center of such lamps or devices. Parking lamps shall not be used in lieu of head lamps to satisfy the requirements of this section.

CHAPTER 135—S.F.No.1721

An act authorizing the commissioner of administration to sell certain real estate in Winona county.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:

Section 1. **CONVEYANCE OF STATE LANDS; WINONA COUNTY.** The commissioner of administration, for the commissioner of natural resources, may sell in the same manner as is provided by law for the sale of surplus state owned lands the following described tract of land and buildings located thereon formerly known as Lutherhaven Bible Camp in the county of Winona, state of Minnesota:

That part of Lots 3, 4, 5, 6 of Block "B" Fern Glen Acres as platted and filed for record in the office of Register of Deeds of Winona County, lying southwesterly of the southwest right-of-way line of Minnesota State Trunk Highway No. 61.

Sec. 2. This act is effective the day following its final enactment.
