179.03 LABOR RELATIONS; POLITICAL ACTIVITIES FORBIDDEN. Any mediator ~~or employee~~, under the provisions of sections 179.01 to 179.17, who exerts his influence, directly or indirectly, to induce any other person to adopt his political views, or to favor any particular candidate for office, or to contribute funds for political purposes shall forthwith be removed from his office or position by the authority appointing him; provided, that before removal the director of mediation services shall be entitled to a hearing before the governor, and any other employee shall be entitled to a similar hearing before the director of mediation services.

Sec. 2. This act is effective the day following final enactment.

CHAPTER 140—S.F.No.3069

An act authorizing the city of Foley to acquire and develop certain land for industrial purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:

Section 1. FOLEY, CITY OF; ACQUISITION OF LAND. In order to promote industry and alleviate substantial unemployment, the city of Foley shall have the power to acquire by purchase, gift or devise, and develop, on such terms as the city council may in its sole discretion from time to time determine, all necessary right, title and interest in and to all or any parts of certain land situated in the city of Foley, described as follows:

The following tracts of land lying and being in the county of Benton, state of Minnesota, described as follows, to wit:

All that part of the Northwest Quarter (N W 1/4), of Section Thirty-five (35), lying north of the Great Northern Railway right-of-way, and west of a line drawn parallel to and 460.25 feet west of the east line of said quarter section line; and all that part of the North Half of Northeast Quarter (N 1/2 of N E 1/4), Section Thirty-four (34), lying south of Trunk Highway No. 23; and all that part of the Southeast Quarter of Northeast Quarter (S E 1/4 of N E 1/4), Section Thirty-four (34), lying north of the Great Northern Railway right-of-way; all of said lands being in Township Thirty-seven (37) north, Range Twenty-nine (29) west, Fourth Principal Meridian, Benton County, Minnesota.

The Southeast Quarter (S E 1/4), of Section Twenty-six (26), Township Thirty-seven (37) north, Range Twenty-nine (29) west, Fourth Principal Meridian, Benton County, Minnesota.

Sec. 2. FINANCING OF ACQUISITION AND DEVELOPMENT.

The city may pay for the acquisition and development of the land described in section 1 out of such funds as may from time to time be available and appropriated by the city council for such purposes, including but not limited to proceeds from the sale of general or special obligation bonds issued in compliance with Minnesota Statutes, Chapter 475 or any other applicable law, including but not limited to Minnesota Statutes, Chapters 429, 462, 472 and 474, and Sections 115.46, 444.075 and 459.14. If the development of land acquired pursuant to this act is paid for from the proceeds of general obligation bonds, the development of such land may include provision for street and sidewalk improvements and other utility services, including water, sanitary sewers, storm sewers or other drainage facilities, and transportation, power and communications facilities, but except with respect to such facilities may not include provision for the construction of structures or buildings on the premises or the furnishing or equipping thereof.

Sec. 3. DISPOSITION OF LAND. At all times before, during or after development of the land pursuant to this act, the city shall have the authority to sell, lease or otherwise dispose of all or part of as much of said land as is then owned by the city, on such terms as the city council may determine to be in the best interests of the city.

Sec. 4. POWERS OF ADDITIONAL AND SUPPLEMENTAL. The powers conferred by this act shall be in addition and supplemental to the powers conferred by any other law. Nothing contained herein shall be construed to restrict the power and authority of the city to develop, lease and sell property acquired pursuant to this act in accordance with Minnesota Statutes, Chapter 474 or any other law from time to time adopted.

Sec. 5. EFFECTIVE DATE. This act shall become effective only after its approval by a majority of the governing body of the city of Foley and upon compliance with the provisions of Minnesota Statutes, Section 645.021.
