The provisions of section 340.11, subdivision 10 shall otherwise govern licenses issued pursuant to this section.

Sec. 2. This act is effective as to each of the counties upon approval by the respective county board of each county and upon compliance with Minnesota Statutes, Section 645.021.

CHAPTER 334—S.F.No.2842 [Coded]

An act relating to public health, authorizing school nurses and other qualified persons to take throat cultures for the purpose of detecting streptococcus infections.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:

Section 1. [145.085] PUBLIC HEALTH; THROAT CULTURES OF SCHOOL CHILDREN AND FAMILY; NURSES QUALIFIED. [Subdivision 1.] A school nurse or, if a school does not have a nurse, a public health nurse assigned to the school or a nurse with whom the school district has contracted to provide health care services may take throat cultures of school children for the purpose of detecting streptococcus infection. If the student has a positive culture, the entire family may also have cultures taken by the aforementioned person. A nominal charge may be made by the school board to cover the cost of materials and laboratory fees.

Sec. 2. [145.085] [Subd. 2.] This act shall not apply to any child who has been reared as an adherent of a religious denomination whose teachings are opposed to such health care procedures.
