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Sec. 4. Minnesota Statutes 1971, Section 471.468, is amended to read:

471.468 BUILDING PLANS; APPROVAL; EXCEPTIONS. On site construction or remodeling shall not hereafter be commenced of any building or facility until the plans and specifications of the building or facility have been reviewed and approved by the local authority. In cases of practical difficulty, unnecessary hardship, or extreme differences, the local authority may grant exceptions from the literal requirements of sections 471.465 to 471.469, or permit the use of other methods or materials, but only when it is clearly evident that equivalent facilitations and protection are thereby secured. Such waivers or exceptions shall be in writing. The provisions of sections 471.465 to 471.469 are applicable only to contracts awarded subsequent to May 22, 1971.

An act relating to natural resources; directing the commissioner of natural resources to acquire necessary easements to provide public access to a certain lake in St. Louis county; appropriating money therefor.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:

Section 1. KUNZ LAKE, ST. LOUIS COUNTY; PUBLIC ACCESS. The commissioner of natural resources shall acquire by purchase, gift, or eminent domain proceedings in the manner provided in Minnesota Statutes, Chapter 117, the necessary easements and rights of way to provide public access to the lake sometimes known as Kunz lake or Little Sand lake located in Sections 5 and 6, Township 55 North, Range 21 West, St. Louis county, Minnesota.

Sec. 2. There is appropriated to the commissioner of natural resources from the game and fish fund a sum of money sufficient to acquire and develop the public access provided for in section 1.
