CHAPTER 504—H.F.No.2589

An act relating to professional corporations; including podiatrists and psychologists within the definition of professional service for the purposes of formation of professional corporations; amending Laws 1973, Chapter 40, Section 2, Subdivision 2.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:

Section 1. Laws 1973, Chapter 40, Section 2, Subdivision 2, is amended to read:

[319A.02] Subd. 2. PROFESSIONAL CORPORATIONS; PODIA-TRISTS AND PSYCHOLOGISTS. "Professional service" means personal service rendered by a professional pursuant to a license or certificate issued to him by the state of Minnesota pursuant to Minnesota Statutes, Sections 147.01 to 147.29, 148.01 to 148.101, 148.52 to 148.62, <u>148.79 to 148.86</u>, 150A.01 to 150A.12, <u>153.01 to 153.15</u>, 156.001 to 156.14, 326.17 to 326.23, or 481.01 to 481.17, or a license or certificate issued to him by another state pursuant to similar laws.

CHAPTER 505—H.F.No.2605 [Not Coded]

An act relating to the village of Grand Rapids; authorizing the issuance of onsale licenses for the sale of intoxicating liquor.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MIN-NESOTA:

Section 1. GRAND RAPIDS, VILLAGE OF; LIQUOR LICENSE. The village of Grand Rapids may issue three licenses each for the onsale of intoxicating liquor in addition to the number authorized by Minnesota Statutes, Section 340.353, Subdivision 5. The provisions of section 340.353, subdivision 5, clauses 3 and 4 shall not apply in the case of licenses issued pursuant to this section.

Sec. 2. This act is effective upon approval by the village council of the village of Grand Rapids and upon compliance with Minnesota Statutes, Section 645.021.
