**CHAPTER 553—H.F.No.3507**

*An act relating to education; education planning innovative developmental evaluative services and programs; modifying certain appropriations; amending Minnesota Statutes 1971, Section 3.926, Subdivision 2; and Laws 1973, Chapter 768, Section 2, Subdivisions 4, and 7.*

**BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:**

Section 1. Minnesota Statutes 1971, Section 3.926, Subdivision 2, is amended to read:

**Subd. 2. EDUCATION; INNOVATIVE DEVELOPMENTAL EVALUATIVE SERVICES; PROCEDURE.** Every program proposal shall be submitted to the council created by section 3.924, not less than ~~six~~ three months before the planned commencement of the program ; ~~except that proposals for programs to commence before April 1, 1972 may be submitted prior to January 1, 1972~~ . The council shall recommend approval or disapproval, or shall modify and then recommend such modification with respect to every proposal submitted to it. The council shall also recommend the amount and type of grant to be made in support of the proposed program in the light of the then currently available moneys in the venture fund, which information shall be provided to the council by the state board of education. The council shall also recommend what rules and regulations, if any, shall be suspended or modified in order to implement the proposal. Only such proposals as are recommended for approval shall be transmitted by the council to the state board, and all such proposals shall be approved and funded from the venture fund by the state board as recommended by the council unless the state board, within 30 days of receipt of a proposal from the council, shall make other disposition of the proposal by formal board action. One half of each grant recommended by the council and funded by the state board may be deemed an interest free loan to be repaid over a five year period.

**Subd. 4. Education Planning Innovative Development Evaluative Services.**

Sec. 3. Laws 1973, Chapter 768, Section 2, Subdivision 7, is amended to read:

Subd. 7. Vocational Rehabilitation.

1974... \$1,947,902. 1975... \$1,952,725.

(1) Salaries, supplies and expenses and Counseling and Care of Persons.

\$1,458,565. \$1,490,275.

(2) Claims, grants, and shared revenues.

\$119,337. \$72,450.

(3) Rehabilitation facilities. \$370,000. \$390,000.

Any unexpended balance remaining in (3) in the first year shall not cancel but shall be available for the second year of the biennium.

None of the amounts appropriated in subdivisions 1, 3, 4, 5, 6, and 7 listed as claims, grants and shared revenues on the official worksheets of the conferees of the senate and house of representatives, a true copy of which is on file in the office of the commissioner of administration, shall be transferred to any other expenditure category other than that for which it was appropriated, except as may be otherwise provided.

The number of state funded positions shall not exceed the number shown on official worksheets.
