*An act relating to armories; defining armory; amending Minnesota Statutes 1971, Section 193.139, by adding a subdivision.*

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:

Section 1. Minnesota Statutes 1971, Section 193.139, is amended by adding a subdivision to read:

**Subd. 4. ARMORIES; DEFINITION.** “Armory” means a building, vehicle storage compound, organizational maintenance shop, or other facility permanently used by the national guard for the storage and maintenance of arms and military equipment, and the training of national guard personnel.

**CHAPTER 96—H.F.No.2425**

*An act relating to cities and counties; investment of city and county funds.*

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:

Section 1. [471.561] **COUNTIES AND CITIES; INVESTMENT OF FUNDS.** In addition to other investments authorized by law, a city or county may invest moneys in their treasury which are not currently needed, in securities issued by the United States government or agency or instrumentality thereof or the state of Minnesota or any agency, instrumentality, political subdivision or municipality therein, when such securities are accompanied by simultaneous repurchase agreements issued by a state or federally chartered banking institution under the terms of which the securities are to be repurchased by the particular banking institution on a specified date at a predetermined price.
