Section 1. MINNETONKA, CITY OF; VOLUNTEER FIREMEN'S RELIEF ASSOCIATION PENSIONS. Notwithstanding the provisions of Minnesota Statutes, Section 69.06, or any other law to the contrary, the bylaws of the Minnetonka Firemen's Relief Association may provide for the payment of a service pension to present or future retired members or both, in an amount not exceeding \$100 per month to each member who has performed 20 years of active service as a member of the volunteer fire department of the city plus an additional monthly amount of \$5 for each full year of service over 20 years, up to a maximum monthly amount of \$150.

Sec. 2. This act is effective upon approval by the city council of the city of Minnetonka and upon compliance with the provisions of Minnesota Statutes, Section 645.021.

An act relating to the city of Roseville; firemen's relief association service pensions; amending Laws 1973, Chapter 464, Section 2.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:

Section 1. Laws 1973, Chapter 464, Section 2, is amended to read:

- Sec. 2. ROSEVILLE, CITY OF; FIREMEN'S RELIEF ASSOCIATION PENSIONS. The village city council shall have the power by ordinance to increase the service pensions authorized by section 1 for 20 years service to a maximum of \$180 per month plus \$9 per month for each year of service in excess of 20 years up to a maximum of \$270 per month. Such ordinance if enacted shall apply to members retiring prior to or after the effective date of the ordinance and no increase shall be granted unless justified by an actuarial survey.
- Sec. 2. This act is effective upon approval by the governing body of the city of Roseville, and upon compliance with Minnesota Statutes, Section 645.021.
