

trunk highway No. 61 northerly of Silver Bay; thence northwesterly along trunk highway No. 1 to Ely; thence southwesterly along trunk highway No. 1 to its junction with trunk highway No. 169; thence southerly and westerly along trunk highway No. 169 to its junction with trunk highway No. 53, and there terminating.

Beginning at a point on trunk highway No. 11 at its junction with trunk highway No. 53 at International Falls; thence easterly along trunk highway No. 11 to its easterly terminus near Island View.

Beginning at a point on trunk highway No. 33 at its junction with interstate highway marked I 35 southerly of Cloquet, thence northerly along trunk highway No. 33 to its junction with trunk highway No. 53.

(c) The commissioner of highways shall

(1) adopt a suitable marking design of signs or informational plaques.

(2) effect the installation of such signs or plaques in public waysides or other public areas as approved and designated by the commissioner.

#### CHAPTER 256—H.F.No.1423

*An act relating to the Minnesota Statutes; providing for publication thereof; amending Minnesota Statutes 1974, Sections 648.31, Subdivisions 1 and 3; and 648.45, Subdivision 4.*

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:

Section 1. Minnesota Statutes 1974, Section 648.31, Subdivision 1, is amended to read:

**648.31 MINNESOTA STATUTE PUBLICATION.** Subdivision 1. **REVISOR TO PREPARE COPY.** Immediately after the end of the ~~biennial-regular~~ session of the legislature in ~~1947-1976~~ and each ~~biennial-regular~~ session thereafter, the revisor of statutes shall prepare printer's copy for a volume to be called "Minnesota Statutes," appending thereto the last year of such ~~biennial~~ session, which shall contain the constitution of the United States, the constitution of this state, all general and permanent statutes in force, an alphabetical index, a table showing the terms of the district courts, and such other information as the revisor of statutes deems desirable and practicable. The decimal system of numbering of sections contained in Minnesota Statutes 1945 shall be continued in all future editions of Minnesota Statutes, except

that the use of alphabetical letters in addition to the decimal numbers is permitted. The form and style of Minnesota Statutes may be changed in such manner as is necessary to improve its quality and to permit the use of electronic data processing equipment, computer compatible media, and other related equipment in connection with its publication.

Sec. 2. Minnesota Statutes 1974, Section 648.31, Subdivision 3, is amended to read:

Subd. 3. **SPECIFICATIONS FOR COPY.** When printer's copy for any edition of Minnesota Statutes is prepared, the revisor of statutes shall compile and include therein, in an appropriate place and classification, having reference to the arrangement and classification thereof, all laws of a general and permanent nature which were enacted at such ~~biennial-regular~~ session and at any extra session held since the last preceding ~~biennial-regular~~ session, assigning to such laws such chapter and section identification as is appropriate. After each section so included there shall be placed a source note indicating the chapter and section of the session law from which the same was derived. Chapters and sections so compiled and included shall be prima facie evidence of the law contained therein in all courts and proceedings.

Sec. 3. Minnesota Statutes 1974, Section 648.45, Subdivision 4, is amended to read:

Subd. 4. Such fund shall be used solely for the payment of expenses incurred by the revisor of statutes in the printing, publication, sale, and distribution of Minnesota Statutes and Session Laws, and no part of such fund may be used in the payment of any expense incurred within the revisor's office for preparing printer's copy for any edition of Minnesota Statutes or Session Laws.

**BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:**

**Section 1. NATURAL RESOURCES; DAM CONSTRUCTION.** The department of natural resources may expend an amount not to exceed \$87,500 for construction of a dam on Tischer Creek within the city of Duluth. The expenditure shall not be made until the city of Duluth has
