
CHAPTER 41—S.F.No.603

An act relating to retirement; survivor's benefits for survivors of a certain member of the Backus firemen's relief association.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:

Section 1. BACKUS, CITY OF; FIREMEN'S RELIEF ASSOCIATION. Notwithstanding any law to the contrary, the Backus firemen's relief association may pay survivor's benefits to the surviving spouse and children of a member who died after May 15, 1974 and who at the time of his death had satisfied the minimum service requirements for a service pension as specified in Minnesota Statutes, Section 69.06, as modified by Laws 1974, Chapter 378, in an amount equal to the amount of the service pension which the member would have qualified for had he been at least 50 years of age and had retired on the date of his death. Conditions for termination of benefits shall be specified by the association.

Sec. 2. This act is effective upon approval by the Backus city council and upon compliance with Minnesota Statutes, Section 645.021.

CHAPTER 42—S.F.No.701

An act relating to state lands; authorizing conveyance of certain parcel of land in Lincoln county.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:

Section 1. CONVEYANCE OF STATE LANDS; LAKE BENTON, CITY OF. Subdivision 1. The governor, upon recommendation of the commissioner of highways, may transfer and convey, by quitclaim deed in the form the attorney general approves and in the name of the state of Minnesota, to the city of Lake Benton, Minnesota, for any purpose, notwithstanding Minnesota Statutes, Section 161.44, approximately 0.44 acres of land in Lincoln county that is no longer needed for trunk highway purposes for a consideration of one dollar. The deed shall state that the purpose of the conveyance is to release any rights arising from the restriction in that certain quitclaim deed between the state of Minnesota and the city of Lake Benton, dated March 7, 1974,
