Subd. 2: BOND SALE. To provide the money appropriated in subdivision 1 the commissioner of finance upon request of the governor shall sell and issue bonds of the state in the amount of \$20,000,000 in the manner and upon the terms prescribed by Minnesota Statutes, Sections 16A.63 to 16A.67 and by the Constitution, Article XI, Sections 4 to 7. The proceeds of the bonds are appropriated to the Minnesota state building fund except as otherwise provided in Minnesota Statutes, Section 16A.64.

Subd. 3. **DEBT SERVICE.** There is annually appropriated from the general fund in the state treasury to the Minnesota state building bond account in the state bond fund an amount sufficient to pay principal and interest coming due on bonds authorized by subdivision 2, in the amount and manner specified in Minnesota Statutes, Section 16A.64, Subdivision 5.

Sec. 3. This act is effective July 1, 1975.

## CHAPTER 416-H.F.No.1309

An act relating to the operation of state government; authorizing the commissioner of administration to establish on a demonstration basis a regional service center comprising selected state agencies and to enter into a lease for purposes of acquiring suitable space for the center.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:

Section 1. [16.014] STATE GOVERNMENT; REGIONAL SER-VICE CENTER; STATE AGENCIES; COMMISSIONER OF ADMINIS-TRATION, LEASING AUTHORITY. Subdivision 1. The commissioner of administration may establish a regional service center on a demonstration basis. The state planning agency and the regional development commission of region No. 2 shall cooperate with the commissioner in establishing the service center. The commissioner shall determine which state agencies shall be included in the service center. The commissioner may determine equitable methods of sharing space, personnel and equipment for the agencies he selects to participate in the demonstration service center.

Subd. 2. The commissioner may enter into a rental lease for a base term of five years with a five year leasehold renewal option for the purpose of acquiring suitable space for the service center.

Subd. 3. The commissioner with the assistance of the state planning agency shall submit a report to the legislature on the progress of the service center demonstration program not later than January 1, 1977.

## CHAPTER 417-H.F.No.1311

An act relating to certain officers and employees of the state and their dependents; providing optional insurance coverage for certain officers and employees; amending Minnesota Statutes 1974, Section 43.491, Subdivision 2.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:

Section I. Minnesota Statutes 1974, Section 43.491, Subdivision 2, is amended to read:

Subd. 2. STATE GOVERNMENT; STATE EMPLOYEES; OP-TIONAL INSURANCE COVERAGE. The following persons enumerated in this subdivision though excluded by Laws 1967, Chapter 103, from coverage, are nonetheless eligible for coverages at their own expense pursuant to the provisions of subdivision 1:

(1) A part time or seasonal employee of the state serving on less than a 75 percent time basis;

(2) An employee of the board of regents of the University of Minnesota on the academic staff serving on less than a 75 percent regular appointment;

(3) A part time or seasonal employee of the board of regents of the University of Minnesota and a member of the civil service staff under the civil service plan serving on less than a 75 percent time basis;

(4) An employee in the unclassified service of the state civil service who is employed by the state college board or the state board for community colleges as a member of the academic staff serving on less than a 75 percent time basis;

(5) An officer or employee of the state agricultural society;

(6) A civilian employee of the adjutant general who is paid from federal funds and who is not eligible to benefits from any federal civilian employee group life insurance or health benefits program  $\tau$ ;

(7) An officer or employee of the state capitol credit union or the hiway credit union.
