*An act relating to the operation of state government for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1975; appropriating money therefor.*

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:

Section 1. **APPROPRIATIONS; STATE GOVERNMENT; DEFICIENCY.** Subdivision 1. The sums hereinafter set forth, or so much thereof as may be necessary, are hereby appropriated out of the general fund in the state treasury or in any other fund designated for the purposes specified in this section to be available for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1975, except as otherwise provided for.
