An act relating to education; defining qualified voters for school district elections; amending Minnesota Statutes 1974, Section 123.32, by adding a subdivision.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:

Section 1. Minnesota Statutes 1974, Section 123.32, is amended by adding a subdivision to read:

Subd. 1a. SCHOOL DISTRICTS; ELECTIONS; QUALIFIED VOTERS. (a) An eligible voter for a school district election shall be a person who at the time of the election:

- (1) Is 18 or more years of age;**
- (2) Is a citizen of the United States;**
- (3) Is a resident of the school district; and**
- (4) Has resided in Minnesota for 20 days.**

(b) The following persons are not eligible voters:

(1) Any person who has been convicted of treason or any felony, who has not had his civil rights restored;

(2) Any person who is under guardianship over his person;

(3) Any person who is adjudicated to be non compos mentis or insane; and

(4) Any person who is not properly registered, if a voter registration system has been adopted for such school district.

Sec. 2. This act is effective the day following its final enactment.
