Any person desiring to possess explosives, other than a person licensed as provided in section 299F.73, shall make application for a permit for the use of explosives to the appropriate local fire official designated in section 299F.10; subdivision 4; or such other person as is designated by the local governing body to act for the local fire official—~~sheriff or chief of police of a city of the first, second or third class, or such other person as is designated by the commissioner of public safety,~~ on a standardized form provided by the commissioner of public safety ~~except that a dealer in explosives licensed under section 299F.73 may receive an application for a permit and issue a permit to a purchaser whose residence or intended place of use is outside the dealer's local community provided that the dealer first verifies the identity of the purchaser and the propriety of the sale by a phone call to the appropriate local fire official designated in section 299F.10; subdivision 4 or such other person as is designated by the local governing body to act for the local fire official.~~

Subd. 2. The application shall require the applicant's name, address, purpose for acquiring explosives, place of intended acquisition, quantity required, place and time of intended use, place and means of storage until such use and whether the applicant is a person to whom no such permit may be issued pursuant to section 299F.77. Any person aggrieved by the denial of a permit may request a hearing before the ~~state fire marshal—~~commissioner of public safety. The provisions of sections 15.0418 to 15.0426 shall apply to such hearings and subsequent proceedings, if any.

Subd. 3. Prior to the storage of explosives, the applicant shall notify the appropriate local fire official.

Sec. 3. This act is effective January 1, 1976.

#### CHAPTER 78—S.F.No.730

*An act relating to motor vehicles; application for certificate of title for a previously registered vehicle; amending Minnesota Statutes 1974, Section 168A.26.*

**BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:**

Section 1. Minnesota Statutes 1974, Section 168A.26, is amended

**168A.26 MOTOR VEHICLES; PREVIOUSLY REGISTERED VEHICLES; CERTIFICATES OF TITLE; APPLICATION.** Sections 168A.01 to 168A.25 do not apply to a previously registered vehicle until:

(1) It is purchased from a dealer in this state after October 1, 1972;

(2) A security interest in the vehicle is created after October 1, 1972;

(3) A certificate of title is issued in this state for the vehicle;

(4) An application is made to transfer the registration of the vehicle more than one year after October 1, 1972;

(5) ~~Three~~~~Four~~ years elapse from October 1, 1972, and then only if it is then subject to a security interest;

(6) Six years elapse from October 1, 1972.

*An act relating to the city of Crystal; providing for the filing of candidates for primary elections; amending Laws 1971, Chapter 213, Section 2.*

**BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:**

Section 1. Laws 1971, Chapter 213, Section 2, is amended to read:

**Sec. 2. CRYSTAL, CITY OF; PRIMARY ELECTIONS; CANDIDATES.** In any resolution fixing the time for the filing of candidates ; ~~the opening date for filings shall be no earlier than the 10th day of August preceding the primary election, and shall close no later than the 25th day of August preceding the primary election for a primary election~~ the filing dates shall be those provided by law for cities of the same class as the city of Crystal .

Sec. 2. This act shall be effective upon its approval by the city council of the city of Crystal and upon compliance with Minnesota Statutes, Section 645.021.
