

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:

Section 1. **INDEPENDENT SCHOOL DISTRICT NO. 279; BOND ISSUANCE.** Independent School District No. 279, whose principal office is in the city of Osseo, in the issuance of bonds authorized by the voters of the district on February 11, 1975, may establish a serial maturity schedule for such bonds which, individually or in combination with the maturities of any other designated issue or issues, will conform to the provisions of Minnesota Statutes 1974, Section 475.54, Subdivision 1, without retiring outstanding state loans to the district, and without conforming to the provisions of subdivision 2 of said section relating to school districts having outstanding state loans.

Sec. 2. This act shall be effective upon approval by a majority of the school board of Independent School District No. 279 and upon compliance with Minnesota Statutes 1974, Section 645.021.

CHAPTER 86—H.F.No.1465

An act relating to the city of St. Paul; authorizing restoration of sick leave in certain circumstances.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:

Section 1. **ST. PAUL, CITY OF; POLICE OFFICERS; SICK LEAVE.** Notwithstanding any law, charter or ordinance provision to the contrary, the city of St. Paul may, by resolution of its governing body, restore to a police officer injured in the line of duty any sick leave accrued to him prior to the injury, regardless of the date of injury.

Sec. 2. This act is effective upon approval by the governing body of the city of St. Paul and upon compliance with the provisions of Minnesota Statutes, Section 645.021.
