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In Ramsey county, the sheriff shall charge <u>a-an additional</u> fee of <u>\$1-to</u> <u>be set by the county board</u> for receiving, indexing and putting in line for service each summons and complaint left with him for service. This fee is in addition to other fees now provided by law, and is to be absorbed by the plaintiff in the action. It is not to be charged to the defendant nor taxed as costs against him in the action or any proceedings ancillary thereto.

Sec. 2. APPROVAL BY BOARD. This act shall take effect upon its approval by the board of county commissioners of Ramsey county, and upon compliance with Minnesota Statutes, Section 645.021.
